WEDDING GUIDELINES FOR VISITING CLERGY

The Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph Parish welcomes ordained priests and deacons to celebrate the sacrament of marriage. We respect the important relationship that has been fostered with the bride and groom as well as their families and we look forward to a wonderful celebration of God's love and grace.

Visiting clergy should be in "good standing" with the Catholic Church and granted the necessary faculties to perform a wedding in the Archdiocese of Chicago. If they are currently serving outside of the Archdiocese of Chicago, they need to contact the Office for Externs and International priests, 312-534-5237 for faculties to be granted to them.

Policies and Procedures:

Visiting clergy are asked to observe our parish customs regarding the celebration of weddings. They are expected to follow the archdiocesan liturgical norms for weddings, so that we are not surprised later by reports of "guess what 'Fr. Visitor' did."

Please note that we provide the engaged couple with information welcoming them to St. Joseph Church and guiding them through the wedding planning process. We ask that you encourage them to read and follow those procedures and guidelines. *Please review our ICSJ Wedding Guidelines regarding the facility & conduct, Photography & Videography, as well as floral decorations.* You may also want to look over our wedding webpage for more information and pictures of the church before your visit: www.icsjparish.org/marriage.

During the time of wedding preparation the visiting clergy are responsible for the following:

- Contacting the pastor of Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph Parish to confirm that they will
 perform the wedding, and provide his contact information. Our Parish Events Coordinator is Jutta
 Keenan. If you need assistance regarding policies, guidelines, or the ceremony, please call her
 at 312-787-7174, ext 2 or email at jkeenan@icsjparish.org and she can assist you.
- Complete with the wedding couple all paperwork required by the Archdiocese of Chicago or local Diocesan norms unless other arrangements have been specifically made.
- Assure that all paperwork is on file with St. Joseph Church no less than one month prior to the
 wedding unless other arrangements have been specifically made. Note. If marriage preparation
 takes place out of the Chicago Diocese, the local Church should send the completed marriage file
 to their Diocese for the Nihil Obstat. The local Diocese will then forward the complete file to the
 Archdiocese of Chicago then on to the parish.
- Have the bride and groom submit the completed ICSJ Wedding Planner to our Parish Event
 Coordinator two weeks before the rehearsal. This is a link couples will receive from Allie via email
 3 months prior to their wedding date.

• Conduct the wedding rehearsal (note that only one hour is allocated for a wedding rehearsal). Be sure to have the Cook County Marriage License at the rehearsal.

Our parish provides Altar Servers and Wedding Sacristans who will assist with the wedding rehearsal and the wedding ceremony as needed. Allie will be in touch with you the week of the wedding to coordinate details on the rehearsal and wedding date to ensure we know how you like to run them.
